His expertise in this field resulted in an assignment to the K-12 education committee of the Business and Industry Advisory Committee in Paris, France as well as serving on the advisory boards for several online learning organizations. He has been recognized with the "Most Outstanding Achievement by an Individual: K-12 Education" award by the United States Distance Learning Association and is a two-time recipient of the Florida Principal Achievement Award.
