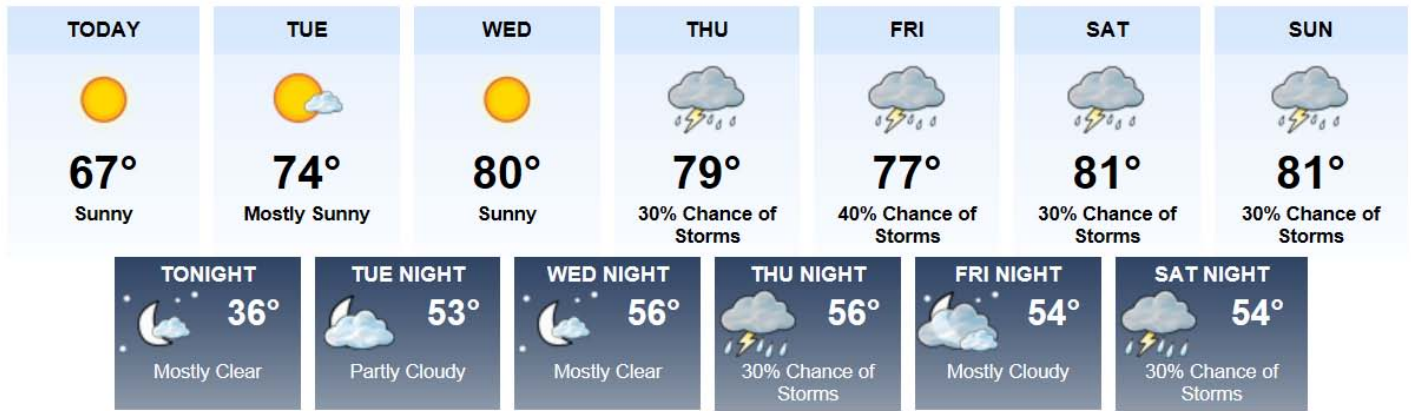

Important news about State Health Plan open enrollment

From Ellaree Clonts, Payroll/Benefits Supervisor

Please note: This advisory only concerns the state health plan. It does not have anything to do with the cafeteria benefits plan!

Open enrollment for the state health plan will be held beginning May 20th and ending May 31st. Please don't wait until May 31st if you are making a change! Open enrollment is the time when you can make changes without a qualifying event, you can change plans, or coverage. These changes will be effective July 1, 2013.

You can go to <https://shp-login.hrntouch.com> to make changes.

By now you should have received in your mail at home a flyer about the enrollment time. THERE IS GOING TO BE A MAJOR SHIFT IN THE HEALTH PLAN IN THE UPCOMING YEAR SO YOU NEED TO READ THE FLYER CAREFULLY AND BE AWARE.

At this time there will not be any changes in coverage, premiums, deductibles however, the SHP is shifting from a July - June plan year

to January - December plan year.

This means that the plan year starting in July will end December 31, 2013, and a new plan year will begin January 1, 2014. *"As a result of the shortened benefit year, your deductibles and out of pocket maximum will reduced by half."*

Open enrollment will be held again the entire month of October to shift into the new plan year. This is when any changes in premiums, deductibles, co-pays, etc. will be known. If there are changes they will go into effect January 1, 2014.

MOUNTAIN YOUTH SCHOOL Graduation 2013 Information

Graduation: Mountain Youth School's Graduation will be held on Thursday, May 23 at 6:00 PM at the First United Methodist Church in downtown Murphy. Graduates must be present by 5:30 PM.

Rehearsal: All seniors and graduates are required to attend a mandatory walk-through and luncheon on Thursday, May 23. We will meet at the First United Methodist Church no later than 10:00 AM to practice the graduation ceremony, make seating arrangements, etc. We will then return to school for a cookout, softball game, talent show, and/or field day.

Senior Dinner: Seniors and their families and friends are invited to attend a celebration dinner, *tentatively* scheduled on Wednesday, May 22 at 6:00 PM at Brother's Restaurant. The seniors' meals will be provided by the school (up to a predetermined budgeted amount), but friends and family will need to pay for their own meals. We will be recognizing seniors' accomplishments, naming senior superlatives, and making note of graduates entering college, the workforce, and the military. December graduates, *please call the school or check the website a week prior to make sure no changes have been made.*

Portraits: Spring senior drape portraits will be taken at the school on Tuesday, May 7. December graduates and current seniors who have not had their portrait made should be present and ready to go at 9:00 AM. Those who had their portrait taken here in the fall do not need to have them retaken. If you had portraits taken at another high school, tell Ms. Parker. If you had portraits taken elsewhere, you need to make arrangements to provide your portrait prior to May 7. *If you did not have your drape portrait made here in the fall, please assume that we do not have your portrait.*

Senior Slideshow: Each senior needs to provide an appropriate quote to accompany their portrait on the senior slideshow by Friday. You can bring or e-mail your quote to Ms. Herr or Ms. D. by Thursday, May 9.

Graduation Speakers: While our keynote speaker will be Murphy Mayor Bill Hughes, we would like to enlist as many seniors as possible in the graduation ceremony. Seniors can lead the Pledge of Allegiance, give the invocation (prayer), and speak on behalf of the class. Speakers should be students who can speak clearly in front of a crowd, and who represent the best of the class.
