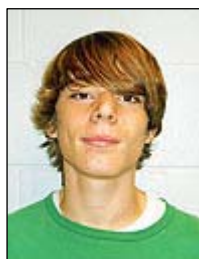

**Something he is good at:** Basketball

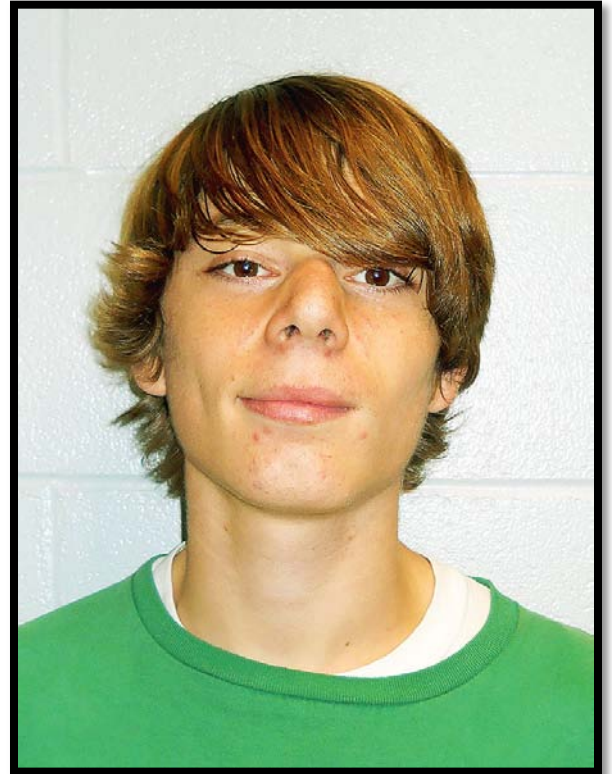
